My Dear Friends,

When I get in a jam with my computer I ring up a friend, who is an expert, for advice. After a very short conversation I hear those welcome words 'I'll come over and show you' because he knows that just telling me is nigh on futile ! Being shown is by far the best way.

This is rather like life. We want to get things right, sort out the mess we are in and make a fresh start. We try by ourselves but without success. What do we do? What can we do? It is no good asking others because they are often in just as much of a mess as we are. Where can we turn for help in our lives?

The answer was given 2000 years ago in Bethlehem - and millions still have not got the message. Jesus is the answer. The prophets of the Old Testament came at regular intervals to tell the people but things did not change. Then at the right time Jesus came to show us the way. Not only does he show us the way, he is the way. Jesus comes each day, not just at Christmas, to show us the way. He knocks at the door awaiting our invitation to come in and sort us out. People would call me stupid if, when my friend came to show me how to sort out my computer, I told him to go away and that I would struggle on alone. But that is the way we so often treat Jesus.

We cannot manage alone. That is why Jesus came. Let him in and he will re-programme us through his Holy Spirit so that we begin to function as God intended.

Jesus is in effect saying to us 'I have come down to show you'. But will we invite him in? May you know this Christmas and in the New Year the blessings which Jesus gives.

**ADVENT** is now with us and 'Cold December', which 'brings the sleet, blazing fire and Christmas treat' as our old rhyme says – YES ! Christmas will soon be here with 'treats' and gifts for many people, especially the children, but the biggest and most important gift of all – the reason for this CELEBRATION and 'treats' is the birth of Jesus at Bethlehem 2,000 years ago. There is so much commercialism today, that this tends to be forgotten, but here we do remember and celebrate with our special services, Christingle and nativity plays. HAPPY CHRISTMAS TO ALL!

### Carlisle Cathedral Visit on 13th Nov

45 people from the Kent Estuary Parishes travelled together by coach to a special service where churches presented their aims to the Bishop for the Carlisle Diocesan Plan 'From Survival to Revival'. Working with young people is Milnthorpe's first priority, the second being to develop the role of the laity. The cathedral was packed and the singing of modern and traditional hymns was enhanced by 'Tapestry', a music group from Keswick. Bishop James preached an inspiring sermon and spoke of **Confidence** in our faith, **Commitment** to mission and **Courage** to take risks in seeking different ways of proclaiming the Gospel to our communities.

On Remembrance Sunday members of village organisations including the Royal British Legion with its standard carried by Ian Mills, the Parish Council, Fire Service, Police, Brownies, Cubs and others marched in procession from the Playing Field to the War Memorial for a short service of Remembrance, which included a reading of the names of the fallen of the two world wars and a two minutes silence, as well as the Last Post and Reveille played by the Reverend Bob Wilkinson. Poppy wreaths were laid. The procession then marched to the Methodist Church for a further Remembrance Service led by the Revd William Seville; the sermon by the Revd Canon John Hancock. All were invited to tea

in the adjoining hall.

An Ecumenical Taize Service for all churches, held at the Church of Christ the King was led by Father Darragon. The service was held throughout in a very powerful and meditative atmosphere. Dedicated to the Children of the World, special prayers were said for the children of African countries where there is drought and fighting – Ethiopia, Rwanda and Sudan; also children caught up in war, Iraq, those of Beslan, and all those who have lost their childhood through terrorism or abuse.



At the November meeting, the service was led by Pat Radcliffe with Bible reading by Joan Ellam. Crosscrake MU members have invited us to their Carol Service December 16<sup>th</sup>. A demonstration of making Christmas cards was given by Gwen Tuer and Dorothy Hornby.

A proposed 'orphan weekend' is to be held when MU branches will collect items for children of African countries.

Congratulations to Mrs Mary Thornburrow, who celebrated her 103<sup>rd</sup> birthday on November 8<sup>th</sup> with her family. A resident of Croftside for the past few years, where there are two other residents each aged 100 years !
