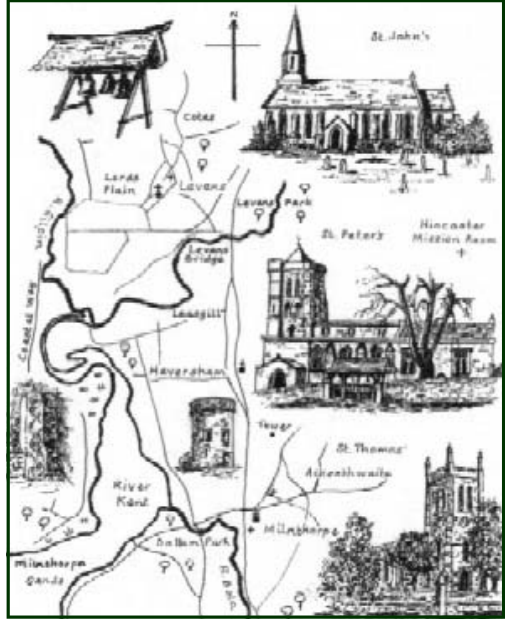

Message from Revd Ruth Crossley – ‘simple living’

Dear Friends,

In May there was on BBC 2 a series of 3 programmes called, ‘How to live a simple life’. In it Peter Owen Jones goes back to basics to try to live a simpler and more meaningful life.

As he reflects on what it means to live in credit-crunch Britain where modern life is often a frenzy of spending and working. He yearns for a life of simplicity and meaning - a deeper connection to both nature and people.

He tries to turn his back on consumerism by downsizing, helping the local farmer and growing his own vegetables, he then decides to give up money. It is a risk, will his friends and neighbours support him as he hones his skills as a gardener, chicken keeper, wood-chopper and dishwasher?

In the second episode he experiments with travelling 200 miles on foot, without food, water or money. He relies on the generosity of those he meets to provide food and shelter and occasionally transport.

He found the experience humbling as he was totally dependent on others. The final episode has yet to be shown but blurb says that Peter finds new ways of giving back, and in the process he discovers a new model of living simply that may be helpful to us all.

Francis was a saint who renounced his wealth and lived a simple life, his example has been followed by many thousands over the years; today ordinary men and women still try to follow his simple life. Part of what they commit to do is to share with others and stay free from attachment to wealth so that they can also share with those who are poor in the world. I often wish I could live more simply without the trappings of consumerism, one day maybe.

Jesus in his life on earth lived a simple itinerant life, teaching, healing and sharing God’s love with the world. Jesus commanded us to love others.

Taking Jesus’ example of love and simplicity of living, we too should love and care for others and creation. Perhaps in our desire to live simply we can start at home, by using our time and money to focus on truly important things like nourishing relationships with our families and communities, serving those who need our help, and working harder for justice, here and abroad.

As Gandhi said, ‘live simply, so that others might simply live.’

At the last Deanery Synod meeting two people involved in the scheme in Kendal spoke movingly about the aim - to restore broken lives and, over a 12-step plan, to help the individual to be able to live independently in the community and to introduce them to the Christian faith. One was himself an ex-offender, had become a Christian, and now counselled others. It was agreed that we would give the proceeds of joint events to this project. We have therefore invited several people involved in various restorative justice programmes to speak at this year's Songs of Praise on July 11th.

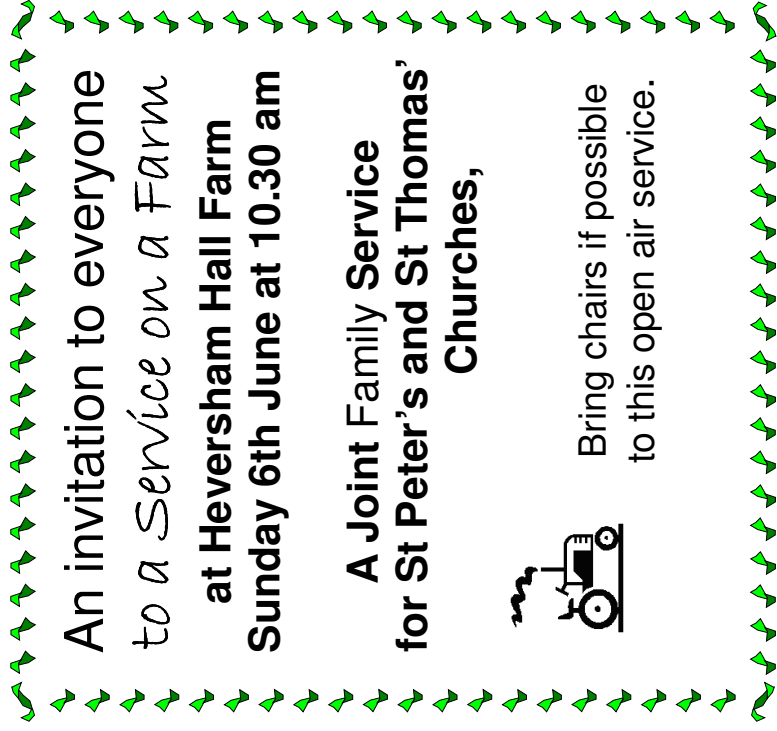

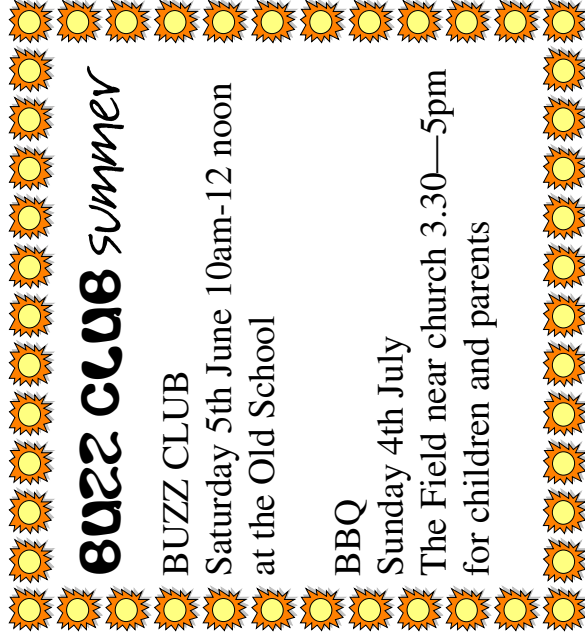

Doreen and George Wadsworth were the speakers at the May meeting. They spoke about their voluntary work in Uganda and their continuing commitment to the community there. They have helped to support the development of the local hospital, seen the major impact of a new electric generator which provides power to outlying villages and been instrumental in the setting up of a scheme which provides goats to vulnerable families. Malnutrition of young children is a major problem and the provision of a goat to provide milk has done much to improve their life chances, where resources are limited.

A special place in Levens

Lane End Plantation is the area of woodland and grassland accessed

from” the Crossings “ on the Levens to Brigsteer Road or from the field opposite Heaves Farm. It is an area rich in wildlife, plants of limestone pasture and woodland and over the past few months staff and volunteers have been working on clearing corridors to link up open areas for butterfly habitats.



This is a special area for wildlife, the local community and visitors, the permitted footpaths giving good access. There have been no real problems with this amount of access except for one, that of dog waste.

The issue isn't that waste is not being picked up it is, that when used, the plastic bags are being left scattered around the site and roadside, sometimes hung on trees and even stored away in tree stumps or holes in the ground for other animals to dig out and scatter.

As a community please help us to solve this problem and keep this place looking well, in whatever way you can.
