Dear Friends,

I suspect that we have all heard or seen something or read something about London 2012. If so, no doubt the name JESSICA ENNIS, the face of London 2012 is familiar, too. Now Olympic Heptathlon Champion.

After Jessica won the other night she was interviewed and first she thanked her coach, then her family and friends. She has had the same COACH since she was 13 and over the years he has drawn the very best out of her as she has grown up and developed. He has also become part of the family. He recognised her gifts as an athlete and has helped her to achieve the highest possible standard she could achieve- BUT it meant that she had to learn to TRUST him and to LISTEN carefully to what he said, and to FOLLOW his guidance and TRAIN HARD.

Day by day, week by week, year by year.

There were times when she struggled, when she got injured and wanted to give up, times when she was tempted to choose a different path, but he helped her over those times, talked to her, guided her, and encouraged her to look ahead, to really believe that she could succeed.

She LISTENED. And she WON!

She is also an inspiration to lots and lots of other young people and a wonderful example to them.



It can be the same with JESUS, our LIFE COACH, if we will let Him help us and train us up, except that HE will always be with us and ALWAYS ready to bring out the very best in each one of us because He knows us better than we know ourselves. It's amazing, but He knows exactly what we need and what we can achieve, and always wants the best for us.

BUT- yes, there has to be a but- we need to learn to get to know Him better, to learn to LISTEN to Him, and to learn to trust Him, to let Him show us the way ahead.

Just like those first disciples. As they found, it isn't always easy and it means choosing to go His way when perhaps other things seem more attractive or tempting. And it meant sometimes standing out in the crowd and being different, but Jesus' way really IS the best way.

Just look at what God did in and through those ordinary men.

He changed the world!

Makes you wonder what He might do if we really LISTEN and we let Jesus our Coach take the lead, doesn't it.

## **The Bishop of Carlisle's Harvest for the Hungry Appeal 2012**

**Mothers' Union's Family Life Programme in Uganda helps communities improve their environment, reduce poverty, improve health and hygiene, generate an income and build strong family and community relationships.**

Beatrice and her family are just one family whose lives have changed. They grew maize but did not have enough fruit or protein in their diet and often worried about what would happen if the harvest failed. Beatrice cooked on an open fire and had to walk further and further to find wood, as the trees were being cut down and the soil was eroding. When the Family Life Programme came to Beatrice's village her life turned around. The community learnt how to grow a variety of crops to improve their diet, and had enough to sell, which provided a vital income.

A woman from a neighbouring village puts it very well: 'Before Family Life Programme, people in the communities expected hand outs – free things. But now the Mothers' Union is giving them knowledge. **Knowledge is better!** They say "with knowledge we can get what we want". This makes a difference... There is a spirit of helping one another and building relationships that before did not exist.

**£10** could help pay for a travel grant so that community development coordinators can reach rural communities in Uganda to offer training and advice.

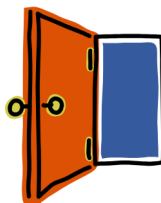

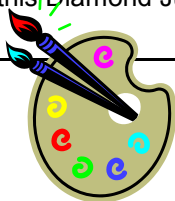
## MILNTHORPE DIAMOND JUBILEE MAP

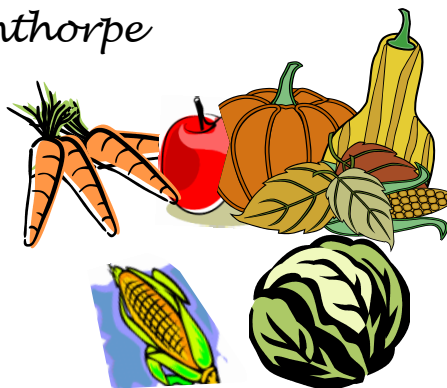
