### Top tips to help you shop safely!

Citizens Advice is finding that people are losing time and money trying to deal with consumer problems. Here are some tips:

- 1. Delivery problems** - It's the seller's responsibility to make sure the item is delivered to the address given. Contact them directly. If they claim they've delivered it or don't know where it is, you can ask for a redelivery, or possibly a refund.
- 2. Defective goods** – you have legal rights to a refund, repair or replacement if the item you bought is broken or damaged, unusable, or not what was advertised.
- 3. What if I change my mind?** - If you buy in store, you don't have a legal right to return goods if you've



simply changed your mind. If you buy online you usually get a cooling off period, but there are some exemptions – check first.

- 4. Pay safe** - Pay by card so you have another form of protection. Be cautious if you're asked to pay in an unusual way, such as in iTunes vouchers, as this could be the sign of a scam.

- 5. Making a return** - Get proof of your return - a receipt from a shop or proof of postage, and tracking where possible. Check the service you use covers the value of the goods.

## St Thomas' Church Milnthorpe

Work to re-order the community rooms and the rear of the nave at St Thomas' Church started in January 2024. The community rooms will be closed for around four months to enable access to the upper and lower rooms to become independent and for the installation of a new kitchen and toilets, including a disabled toilet.

The work will also include the removal of pews at the rear of the nave to provide an alternative community space during the works and in anticipation of a second phase at a later date to provide secure storage and a Parish Office with a balcony over, subject to further fundraising.

The PCC hopes to be able to keep the Church open throughout the works using the North Porch, but any necessary closures will be signed on the notice board by the Church steps.

Dear Friends,

Christmas often seems more popular than Easter in popular imagination. After all, Christmas has a message that is easier to understand: a message of birth and a baby.

But as for Good Friday and Easter? A man dies in the first century and we are supposed to celebrate? Yes, Jesus may have been a great man. He may have been an innocent man. He may have died a barbaric death. But what is so important about a man that died? That is stark and shocking. No wonder people adorn the Easter celebration with chocolate, eggs and a bunny.

For Christians the Easter message is of vital importance. Jesus' death on a cross is not the end of the story. It is not a matter of shame and foolishness but where we see the power and wisdom of God.

Some people link the Easter story to the life symbolised in the eggs and the flow of the seasons from winter to springtime: new life is around us. While there is a truth there, the message of Jesus' death and resurrection is more than new birth. It is about our wrongs being forgiven, death exposed and defeated, Jesus being declared ruler over heaven and earth, God's kingdom restored, and judgement to come. Simply linking a concept like new birth to the annual renewal of the seasons does not come close to conveying it. And that whole theme is lost to people in Australia, for example, who are entering autumn not spring.

Easter brings an uncomfortable but vital message. It demonstrates the full extent of God's love, and also the extreme measures it takes for God to deal with the ills of the world. It is a message that reminds us of our mortality. It is a message that demands repentance. The death and resurrection of Jesus is central to the whole of human history and eternity. Christ has risen from the dead to live and rule for evermore.
